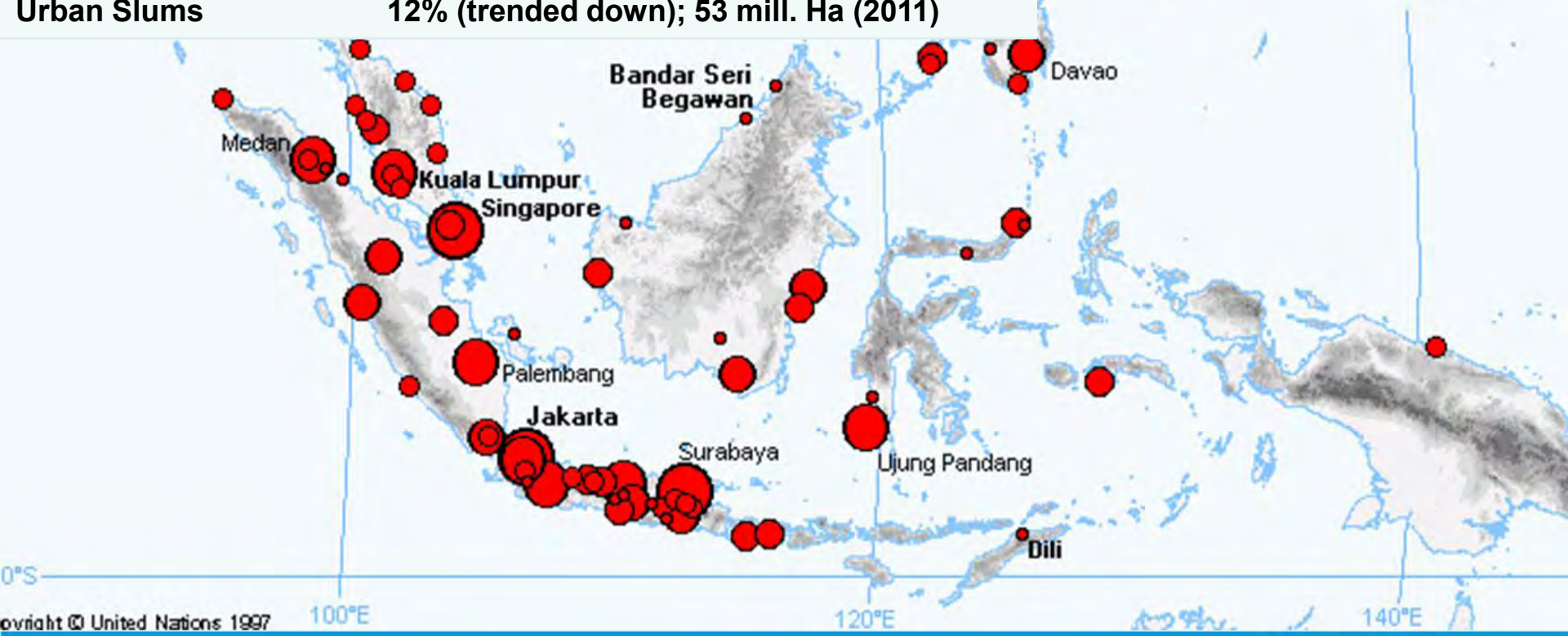
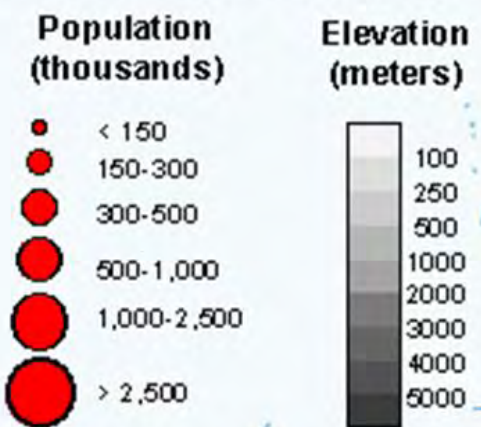

- **“A strong leadership is a key for success.”**

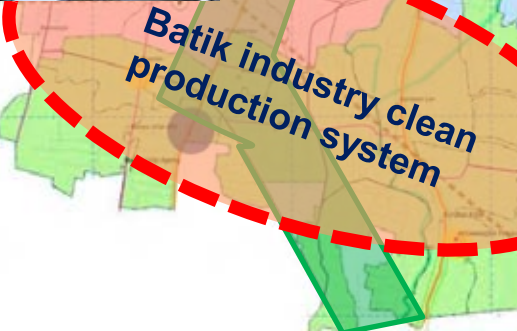
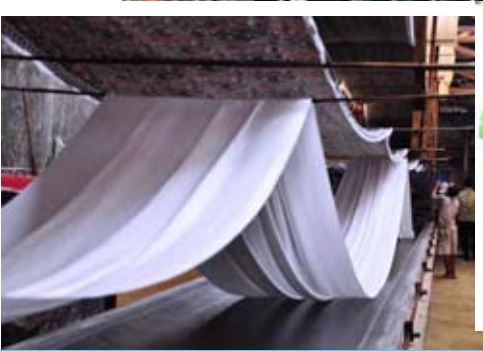
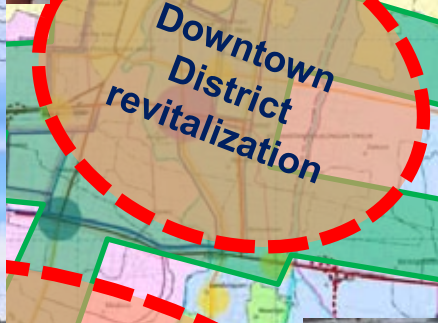
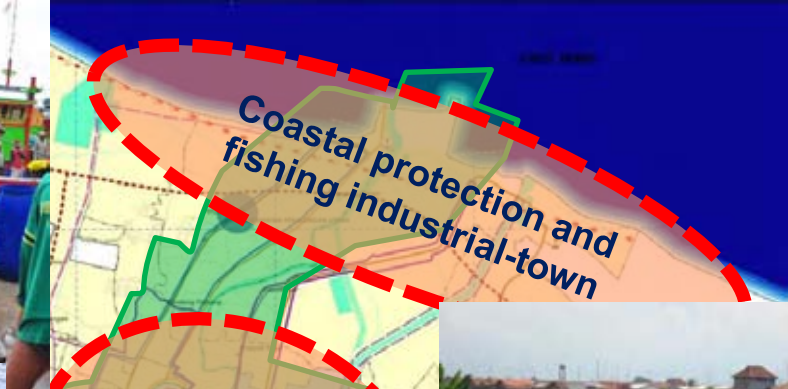
# PARTICIPATORY PROCESS OF ALL STAKEHOLDERS

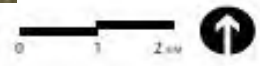
