QUẢNG NAM HƯỚNG TỚI TĂNG TRƯỞNG XANH

QUANG NAM GREEN GROWTH INVESTMENT FORUM

The Quang Nam Green Growth Investment Forum opened on June 23 in Hoi An City, in the central province of Quang Nam to discuss sustainable development and introduce investment opportunities in Quang Nam and other provinces in the region. The event was co-organised by the provincial people's committee, the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) and the Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI).



Overview of Quang Nam Green Growth Investment Forum

This was the first forum of its kind to be held by a Vietnamese province, and was part of this year's Quang Nam Heritage Festival. It introduced investment opportunities to donors, development agencies and potential investors specialising in developing green cities and industries and eco-tourism.

Chairman of the Quang Nam People's Committee, Le Phuoc Thanh, said that the province's orientation towards green growth, a low carbon economy and the conservation and careful use of natural resources has become a key trend in the pursuit of sustainable development.

Reducing carbon emissions and increasing the ability to absorb greenhouse gases have also gradually become mandatory elements in economic development, all of which offer opportunities, as well as significant challenges for Quang Nam, he added.

One of the province's priorities is to promote the eco-city and green city models for Hoi An and Tam Ky, while upgrading infrastructure and developing green industries and eco-tourism in line with preserving its cultural heritage and eco-systems.

This event also covered two thematic sessions urbanisation and green institutional development towards green growth and economic development and natural resource management towards green growth, where participant shared their experience and best with practices Quang Nam Province. An exhibition was held alongside the seminar, providing an opportunity for participants to see green goods produced in Quang Nam, Hoi An handicraft products designed by the National University of Arts of Korea and best practices from Suwon and Portland, environmentally-friendly products from social enterprises and current development partner initiatives from GGGI and UN-Habitat. The event offered an ideal networking opportunity for participants to promote green growth.
