  - ② Make a separate name list by school. (Use Attachment 2)

  - 4 We do not return the original drawings to applicants.
  - Submitted drawings will belong to UN-Habitat ROAP Fukuoka and may be used for its promotional materials.

Any submission with illegible handwriting will not be considered for the contest.

# a. First Judging

The first judging will take place at UN-Habitat ROAP - Fukuoka and a certain number of drawings will be selected as *excellent drawings*.
